2011 FALL CLEAN UP

Items will be collected on your regular collection day. Please place landfill, metal and regular household waste in separate piles, as they are collected on different days. All items must be curbside by 7:00 am.

LANDFILL COLLECTION: SEPTEMBER 12 – SEPTEMBER 23

- Boards, plywood and drywall, within size and weight limits (place small pieces in a bag).
- Furniture, carpet, mattresses and insulation.

METAL COLLECTION: SEPTEMBER 26 – OCTOBER 7

- Fridges and freezers *must* have doors removed and display the green Nova Scotia Department. of Environment "Refrigerant Free" sticker. Air conditioners and dehumidifiers must also display this sticker. You can also bring these items to the Lunenburg Regional Community Recycling Centre (LRCRC) for CFC removal.
- Small auto parts will be collected if all lubricants and coolants have been drained and items are within weight and size limits.
- No engine blocks or transmissions.
- Please drain all gas and oil from lawn mowers.
- Break down swing sets into pieces no longer than 1.8 m or 6 ft.
- Cut 200 gallon drums in half and drain, remove the end of 45 gallon drums.
- Paint cans: Metal cans that are *empty* and dry may be placed in your metal pile (remove lids). Plastic cans that are *empty* must be placed in a black bag.

Please place clean up items in a separate pile from your regular waste. **Do not** put out cans containing paint, household hazardous waste, propane tanks, or tires with cleanup items. Paint cans containing unused paint must be taken to an Enviro-Depot or to the LRCRC for recycling. Take refillable propane tanks and tires to the appropriate dealer. Containers with unidentified contents will not be collected.

Printers, computers and parts, televisions, home and car audio/video systems, and cellular and non-cellular phones will not be picked up during clean up. Drop them off for FREE at Atlantic Canada Electronics Stewardship and Recycle My Cell drop off locations such as Corkum's Recycling in Oakhill or Lilydale.

TANCOOK ISLAND RESIDENTS will have metal and landfill clean up *together* on Wednesday, September 14, for half of Big and Little Tancook Islands and the remainder of Big and Little Tancook Islands will be on Wednesday, September 21. No Household Hazardous waste will be collected on these dates. Landfill and metal must be placed in separate piles for collection. Please observe weight restrictions and place waste wharveside by 7:00 am.
