General Cleanups

There will be two general cleanups during the year. Your pickup will be on your regular day during that week: Spring Cleanup - week of May 9 - 13; Fall Cleanup - week of October 10 - 14. (NOTE: No hazardous waste, banned electronics / cell phones, tires, paint, leaves or yard waste will be collected in General Cleanups. Watch for seasonal advertisement in local paper with more details.) Place metals in a separate pile, next to other cleanup material. NOTE: Do not put out your garbage or green cart on Cleanup Day.

Christmas Tree Collection

Christmas trees will be picked up the week of January 10 - 14, on your regular collection day. Include wreaths and other decorations with regular garbage.



Leaf and Yard Waste Cleanups

Two cleanups of leaves (contained in clear plastic bags) and yard waste (bundled in armfuls, pieces to be no longer than 3 feet with individual branches no thicker than 2 inches) will be undertaken during the year - the week of May 2 - 6 and the week of November 14 - 18, both on the regular collection days.

Storm Cancellations / Holidays:

A pickup day that is cancelled due to winter storm conditions will be rescheduled for the upcoming Saturday and/or advertised via local radio.

***Pickup is not rescheduled for Easter Monday, Victoria Day, Natal Day, Thanksgiving Day, Boxing Day.*

Green Week - Compost Cart (kitchen scraps, leaves, soiled paper, etc.), **Garbage** (Styrofoam, clothing, diapers, etc.) and **Yard Waste** (Leaves or grass in compost cart or clear bag. Individual branches no thicker than 2 inches, bundle max. 3-ft. length). Limit per dwelling unit: 3 bags or bundles of yard waste. Max. 55 lbs. per bag. Total 200 lbs. (or 70 cubic ft.) compost & garbage.



Blue Week - Recyclable Items (clean plastic, glass, metal cans, etc.) in blue recycle bags. Limit per dwelling unit: Max. 55 lbs. per bag. Total 200 lbs. (or 70 cubic feet). **Paper & Clean Boxboard** (clean boxboard, egg cartons, books, flyers, etc.) in grocery or clear bags or tied in bundles. **Corrugated Cardboard** (wavy lines in the middle) flattened & tied in bundles no larger than 3'x2'x2'.
