Terms and Conditions

Holder of permit (applicant) shall:

1. Save and hold harmless the Municipality against all claims for personal injury and/or property damage of whatsoever nature, both during and after the execution of work.
2. Bear ALL damage costs during the laying of the pipe or other work undertaken to the road shoulders, ditches, culverts, pavements and other installations and all subsequent damage cost to the highway that are, in the opinion of the Municipality attributable to the work under the permit.
3. The work shall be carried out in accordance with the latest edition of the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Traffic Control Manual.
4. Provide that on completion of the work, the road shoulder shall be left in a neat condition and dressed with gravel containing no stones of 20 mm in largest dimension.
5. Carry out the work in every respect satisfactory to the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg.
6. Applicant will notify the Municipality when work is to commence and when work is completed.

In consideration of an application as set forth above for consent for access to a listed highway and/or the erection of a structure within 100 meters of the centerline of a listed highway, consent is hereby given.
