

COMMUNITY RECREATION PROGRAM

The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg offers a Community Recreation Program Grant to assist community organizations in the delivery of cultural, social, heritage and/or recreation programs.

The assistance requested should provide for program delivery and/or leadership development.

Funding Use

- A new program, including associated equipment; or
- An improvement or expansion of an existing program and associated equipment; or
- The development and/or training of local leadership

Eligibility

- Only not-for-profit organizations delivering programs to the residents of the Municipality of the District of Lunenburg are eligible
- Applicants must demonstrate that the program contributes to the community and can be completed within the time line indicated
- For organizations that offer multiple programs, any application for a program grant must be endorsed by the sponsoring organization
- Maintenance projects such as equipment repair or replacement are ineligible. These items may be eligible under the Community Recreation Capital program
- Applicants are eligible to receive a grant, provided that a clear 24 (twenty-four) months has passed between any previous grant application and the date of award, under this program
- Projects started prior to application will not be considered
- Must be for a public program where the need for financial assistance is demonstrated
- The program must have a direct link to the organization applying. The Municipality will not consider applications in which a non-profit group is "sponsoring" the project/program.
- Applicants must agree to recognize the Municipality for its contribution (e.g. banner, public announcement, sign)

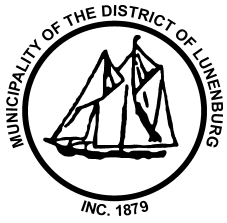
Procedures

- A completed, signed application form is required
- Applications will be accepted throughout the year, allow 1 to 2 months prior to anticipated start date for processing
- Applicants must submit a proposed program budget, including total revenues from all sources
- Applicants must include a profile of the organization, including the people/community to be served by the program and explain how the program will be of benefit to the community
- Applications require approval from the Director of Recreation
- Applications not commenced or completed within 24 months from the date of award may apply for an extension

Funding

- Applicants are eligible for up to 75% of the total cost of the program to a maximum of \$500.00
- Upon approval of a grant, the recipient can request 75% of the grant upon project start. The final 25% is available upon proof of program delivery and completion
