If you are a resident of the Municipality and possess a financial background, accounting designation and/or experience in financial reporting and auditing, the Municipality invites you to submit a letter of interest on or before Friday, June 11, 2021. The letter of interest should include a resume outlining any relevant education and experience.

The Audit Committee is required to meet a minimum of two times in each fiscal year. The term of the appointment is for three years.
