

Fire Service Leadership Training Grant – Group Guidelines

The Municipality of the District of Lunenburg (MODL) recognizes our firefighters' vital role in the community. Leadership training for officers and executives is an essential part MODL's Fire Services Recruitment and Retention Strategy and will contribute to a stronger volunteer service.

Funding Use

- To contribute to training that develops leadership in the areas of volunteer management, communication, or other related leadership training.

Eligibility

- The applicants must be a member of a volunteer fire department or commission within MODL.
- The applicants must have the approval of their Department Chief.
- Eligible training may include webinars, courses, workshops, or seminars that will develop skills and knowledge to be effective leaders. This is not an exhaustive list – if in doubt, please contact our Fire Services Coordinator.
- Hotel and travel costs for individual members are not eligible. Hotel and travel costs for bringing in a trainer or trainers from outside of Lunenburg County are eligible.
- Fire ground operations and/or medical first responder training is not eligible unless the course has a focus on leadership skills.
- Application must be approved before taking the training.

Procedure

- Submit a completed signed application form.
- Applications will be received throughout the year.
- Applications are approved by the Fire Service Coordinator.
- Grant funds are distributed once the applicant provides proof of payment to the Fire Services Coordinator.

Funding

- Applications for group training are eligible for up to 100% of funding up to \$3,000.00.
